

New Providence Elementary **Arrival & Dismissal**

Doors open. Students will report to classroom

hallways or the cafeteria for breakfast.

7:20 am Students report to their classrooms.

Tardy bell rings. **After 7:40**, you must **escort your child** to the office to be signed in. Instruction begins.

2:20 pm Instruction ends and students are dismissed.

If you need to dismiss your child early, please dismiss them in the office prior to 1:50 pm.

Car riders: Anyone picking up a student by car MUST use the car line. We will not be able to accommodate pick-up at the crosswalk for afternoon dismissal.

If you do not have your car tag, please park and come to the office with your ID for a replacement. You will then re-enter the car line for dismissal.

Morning Arrival Safety

For everyone's safety, we encourage all families to use the CAR LOOP for drop-off.

If you wish to park, please PARK in the parking lot.

NEVER drop your child off in the parking lot.

Always WALK your child to the crosswalk.

Please AVOID parking on grass.

When exiting the parking lot, please obey the STOP SIGN.
Wait for the car line to stop before exiting.

WAIT with your child at the crosswalk until a staff member allows them to cross.

DISABLED parking spots are reserved for those with a disabled car tag.

Please try to ARRIVE before 7:30. Students will be marked tardy at 7:40.



Did you know???

- Your child must be in school at least 50% of the school day to be counted present.
- ✓ To keep your child from being truant: according to SC State law, every time your child is absent, our attendance office must be notified in writing with a medical excuse or parent note.
- Each student is only allowed 10 parent notes for the entire school year.
- ✓ An email to the teacher is always appreciated but is not considered a valid excuse. The attendance office must be contacted in writing for every absence.
- We ask that you always try to keep your child's absences, tardies and early dismissals to a minimum and provide a medical/dental excuse when possible.
