### **CHANGES ARE COMING SOON!**

We are thrilled with the news that Lexington County has been identified as "Moderate Community Spread" for the past two weeks. We will begin implementation of some new procedures on Monday, November 15th and will continue gradual implementation over the next several weeks. Here are some important changes you can expect:



- **Monday, November 15th** We will return to eating in the cafeteria. Students will be seated with their homeroom class and a seating chart will be maintained. We will spend time tomorrow reviewing lunch procedures and expectations.
- Monday, November 15th We will begin accepting applications for volunteers to be cleared.
- Monday, November 15th We will begin to implement changes in our Learning Commons working towards open check-out of books in the coming weeks, rather than a two-week rotation (\*Note: This is a slight change from the original information sent home).
- Monday, November 29th Guests for lunch will be allowed for Grades K,2,4 We must have time to get children used to eating in the Cafeteria (November 15-23). Therefore we will allow parents to begin scheduling a time to eat with their child beginning Monday, November 29th.
  - We will alternate days beginning Monday, November 29th with K, 2, and 4 then Tuesday, November 30th grades 1,3,5.
  - Sign-up (reservation) information will be sent next week.
  - 8 parents per day, per grade will be the maximum as we must distance tables on the stage 6 feet apart (we have 8 tables available).
  - Parents may eat with their child only.
  - No outside food may be brought in; parents are welcome to order from our Cafeteria line
- Monday, November 29th Recess modifications will be implemented and children will have 2 recess periods per day with another class.

While we are excited about the upcoming changes, safety of all students is our #1 priority. We are still encouraging distancing, proper handwashing and other strategies we have put in place for some time now. Please be on the lookout for more information soon.


## Attention Business Partners and NPE Families...
