Did you know???

- Each student is only allowed 10 parent notes for the entire school year.
- An email to the teacher is always appreciated but is not considered a valid excuse. The attendance office must be contacted in writing for every absence.
- We ask that you always try to keep your child's absences, tardies and early dismissals to a minimum and provide a medical/dental excuse when possible.


