Important Attendance Reminders

Did you know???

- ✓ Your child must be **in school at least 50% of the school day** to be counted present.
- ✓ **To keep your child from being truant:** according to SC State law, every time your child is absent, our attendance office must be notified in writing with a medical excuse or parent note.
- ✓ Each student is **only allowed 10 parent notes** for the entire school year.
- ✓ An email to the teacher is always appreciated but is not considered a valid excuse. The **attendance office must be contacted** in writing for every absence.
- ✓ We ask that you always try to keep your child's **absences, tardies and early dismissals to a minimum** and provide a medical/dental excuse when possible.

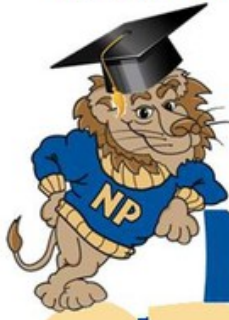
