ATTENDANCE & REPORTING SCHOOL ABSENCES

Every time your child is absent, the attendance office needs to be notified in writing (medical excuse or parent note). See options below. This will keep your child from being truant. Please be aware that a student is only allowed 10 parent notes per school year, so always try to provide a medical excuse when possible.

- 1. You can email a medical/dental excuse to aharrison@lexington1.net (preferred)
- 2. Submit a Parent Note electronically "Click Here" (preferred)
- 3. Send in a written excuse or a copy of a medical excuse with your child upon his/her return.

Also, please know that sending an email to your child's teacher is appreciated, but is not considered a valid excuse. You must communicate with the attendance office. If you have questions regarding attendance, please email aharrison@lexington1.net or call 803-821-3304.

Late School arrival and Early Dismissals...

Please keep all late arrivals and early dismissals to a minimum. Students must be present for at least 50% of the school day in order to be counted present for the day.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND IN OUTSIDE FOOD...

Outside food deliveries to the Main Office will not be allowed. This includes restaurant lunches and items sent in for birthday celebrations.

Items can be purchased through our Cafeteria for birthday celebrations (see the order form below). And this year, breakfast and lunch are free!





All year, breakfast will be eaten in the classroom. For at least the first three weeks, lunch will be eaten in the classroom.

Breakfast (for those who get a breakfast at school), will be picked up in the Commons Area on the way in. Lunch will be delivered to classrooms (for those who eat school lunch).

Students may bring a lunch from home in a lunchbox, however,



please know these cannot be heated or kept cool in the classroom. As we are using "high-incidence" protocols, at this time, parents will not be able to join students for lunch.

Once again, in 2021-2022, both breakfast and lunch are provided at no charge to all students.


