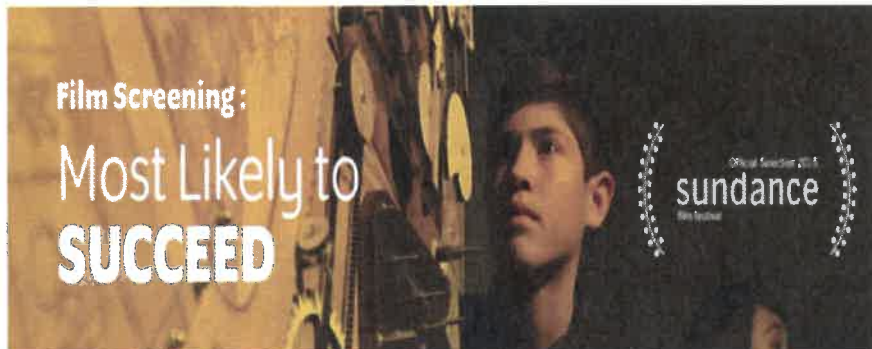

“Future ready” classroom initiative goal

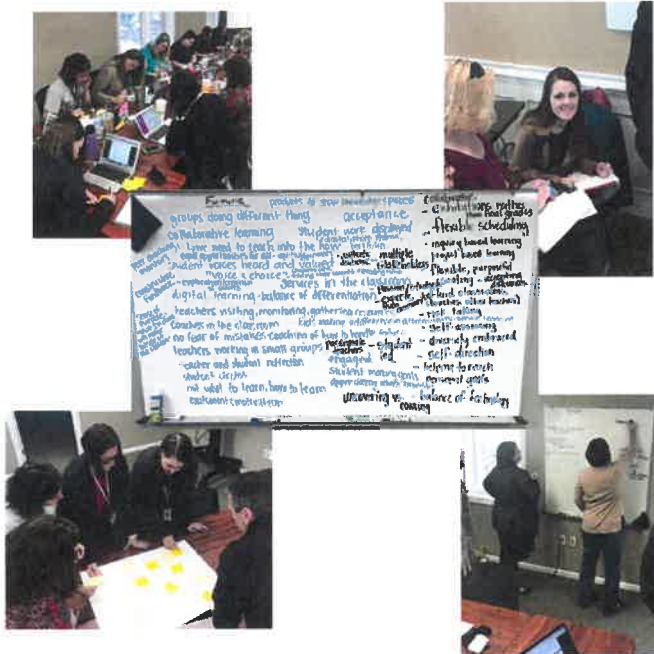
- Provide “future ready” classroom upgrades to all 2,036 classrooms in the district.
- Components - technology and furniture upgrades

Developing the Classroom Model

- Developed the model based on feedback from key stakeholders.
- Collaborative approach to gathering information.

Listen to the source...

- Began focus groups in early Fall 2017
- Discussed changing demands and advances in technology
- If we need to update our approach, what updates to structures and tools do we need to do the work?



Results - feedback for a future ready classroom

- Flexible/movable furniture with varied seating options
- Maximize wall space with whiteboards for making thinking visible
- Mobile teacher workstations
- Additional electrical outlets/USB plugs
- Enhanced wireless infrastructure
- Multiple displays for use with multiple small groups
- Access to different computing devices and software
- Teleconferencing hardware/software for connecting with experts outside of the building
- Virtual reality hardware/software

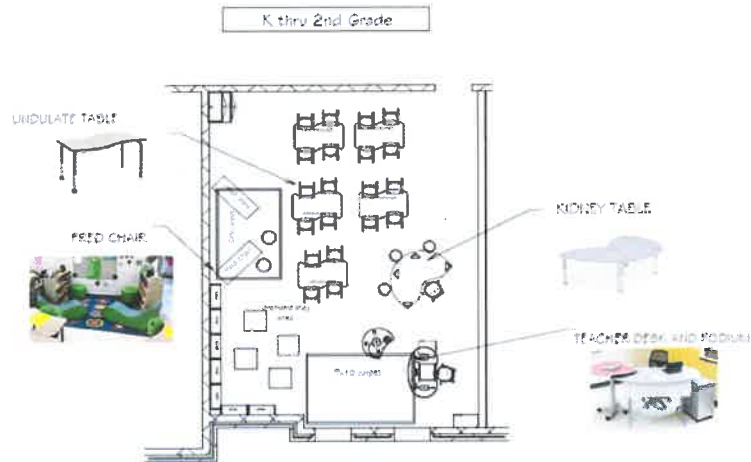
Furniture evaluation

- Gathered feedback from our experts in the field

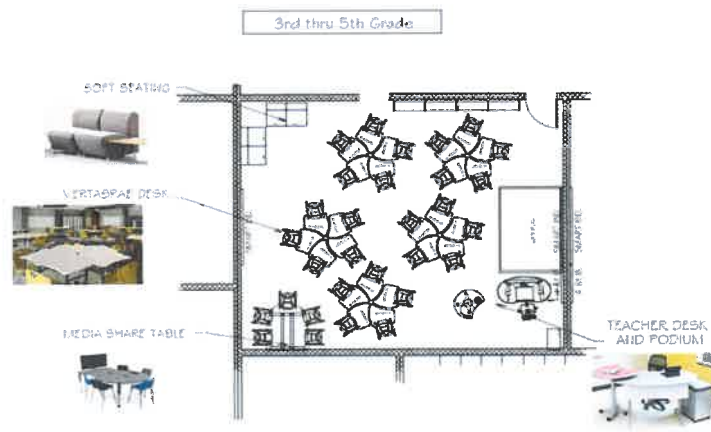

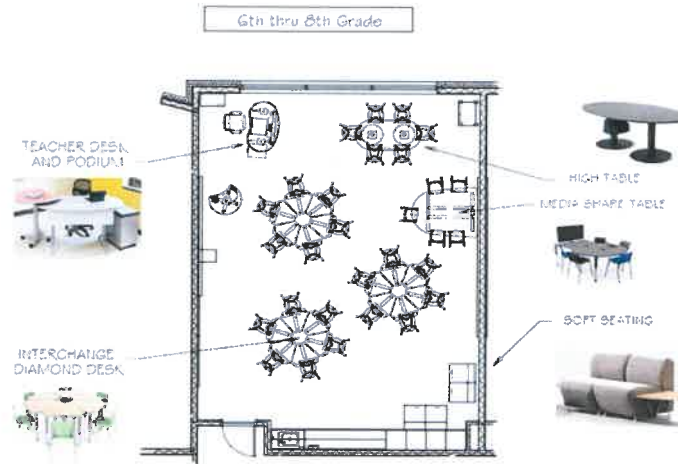
Furniture for future ready classrooms: grades K-2



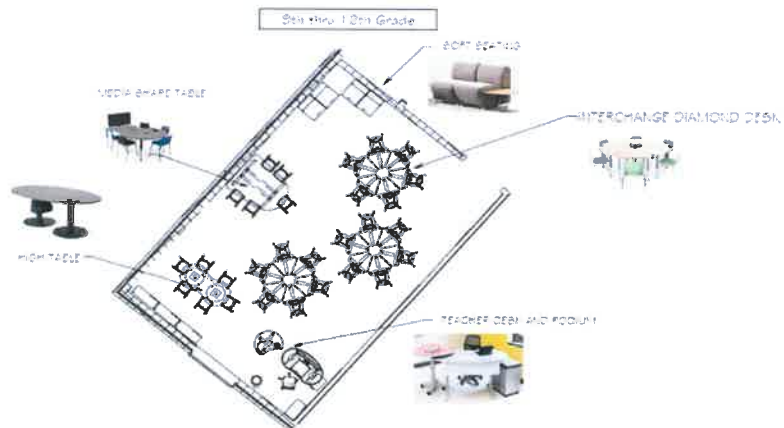
Furniture for future ready classrooms: grades 3-5

Funding of the 2018 Bond Referendum

2008 Bond Referendum

- \$336 million dollars
- 5 schools
 - Lexington Attendance Area
 - 2 elementary schools, 1 middle school, 1 high school
 - White Knoll Attendance Area
 - 1 elementary school
- Renovations at 15 other district locations
- Technology/security upgrades across the district



2008 Bond Referendum

- Millage for debt service was 73.3 mills in 2008
- District agreed not to raise millage more than 12 mills to pay for the referendum
- After all projects were completed in 2015 the debt service millage was 71.3 mills
- Millage *decreased* by 2 mills

2018 Bond Referendum

- \$393 million currently proposed
 - New Schools - \$210 million
 - Additions - \$65 million
 - Renovations and Building Systems - \$45 million
 - Safety and Security - \$18 million
 - Furniture and Technology - \$55 million



2018 Bond Referendum

- The district would not increase the millage more than 19 mills to fund the referendum
- An increase of \$95 to homeowners assessed at \$100,000
- An increase of \$114 to businesses assessed at \$100,000
- Around half of the debt service millage is offset by our local one cent sales tax
